### PRESS NOTE

1. Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2018 as qualifying date, has been completed in NCT of Delhi with final publication of electoral roll on 10.01.2018. The objective of the Special Summary Revision – 2018 was to get fresh enrolment i.e. who have attained age of 18+ as on qualifying date i.e. 01.01.2018 and giving opportunities for correction in electors particulars and also to invite objections against any wrong inclusion in the Electoral Roll. Special Summary Revision-2018 was carried out as per the schedule prescribed by the ECI as under:

## 2. MAIN HIGHLIGHTS OF SPECIAL SUMMARY REVISION-2018:-

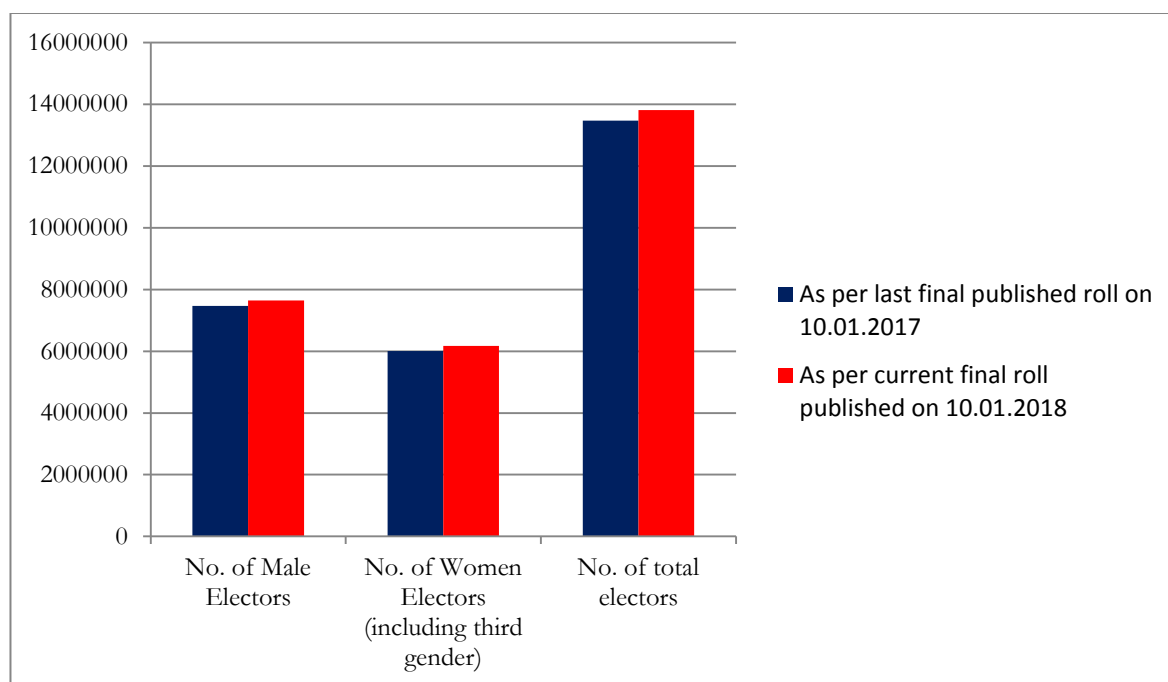
- a. Total 88,968 electors have been added and names of 31,644 electors have been deleted from the electoral roll. Accordingly, 57,324 net electors have increased in the electoral roll during the Special Summary Revision-2018.
- b. Total electors in the final electoral roll of the NCT of Delhi as on 10.01.2018 are 1,38,14,866 which is 3,44,603 (2.55%) more than the total electors of 1,34,70,263 in the last final electoral roll published on 10.01.2017
- c. Names of 27,223 expired electors have been deleted from the electoral roll since the last final publication of the electoral roll held on 10.01.2017.
- d. Names of 39 Millennium Voters, whose date of birth is 01.01.2000, have been enrolled during the Special Summary Revision.
- e. Gender Ratio of the electors registered in the final electoral roll has increased to 808 as compared to the gender ratio of 805 in the final roll last published on 10.01.2017.
- f. A Special Drive was carried out as part of the Special Summary Revision-2018 during the period from 15.11.2017 to 15.12.2017 where in house to house visits were conducted by the Booth Level Officers (BLOs) for identification of the future voters. During the Special Drive, 11,501 future voters have been identified who will be turning 18 on the next qualifying date of 01.01.2019.
- g. There has been substantive increase in the gender ratio of voters of age-group 18-19. It has increased from 624 from last year to 632 in the present year.
- h. A detailed exercise of rationalization of polling stations was carried out as pre-revision activity to the Special Summary Revision-2018 in August-September, 2017 to decongest the existing polling stations. As a result of this exercise, the number of polling stations has increased from 13372 to 13418 and number of polling locations has increased from 2663 to 2670.

3. **SVEEP** :- Various SVEEP activities for awareness of prospect electors were organized during Special Summary Revision which includes announcement in Delhi Metro, Advertisement through print media, FM Radio jingles etc.

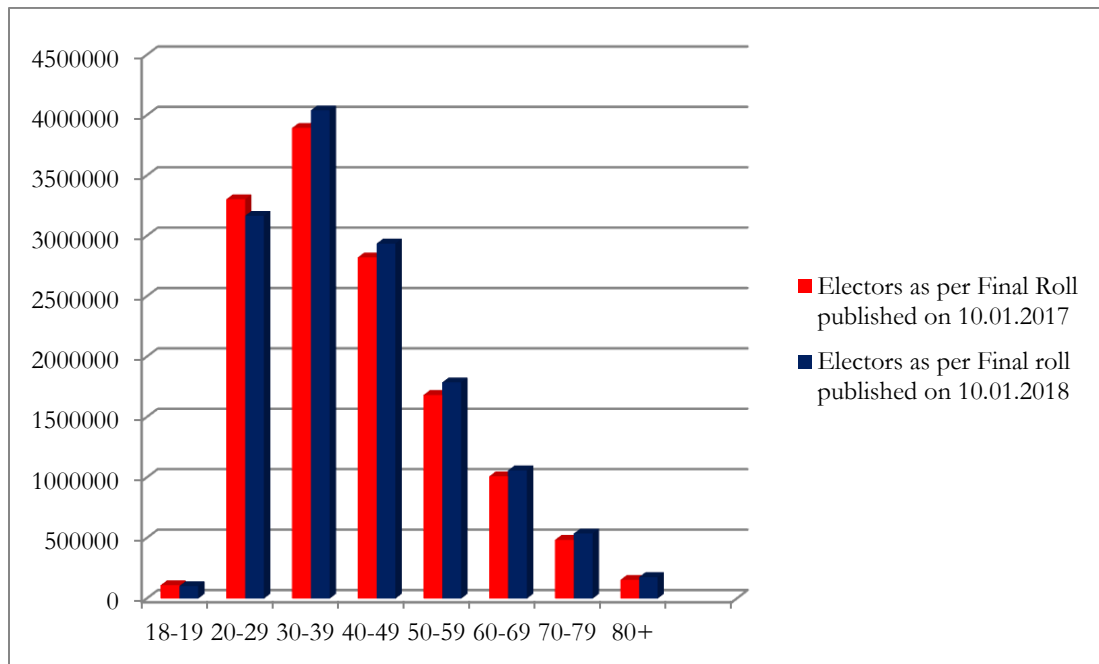

5. **COMPARISON OF ELECTORS (MALE, FEMALE & TOTAL)**



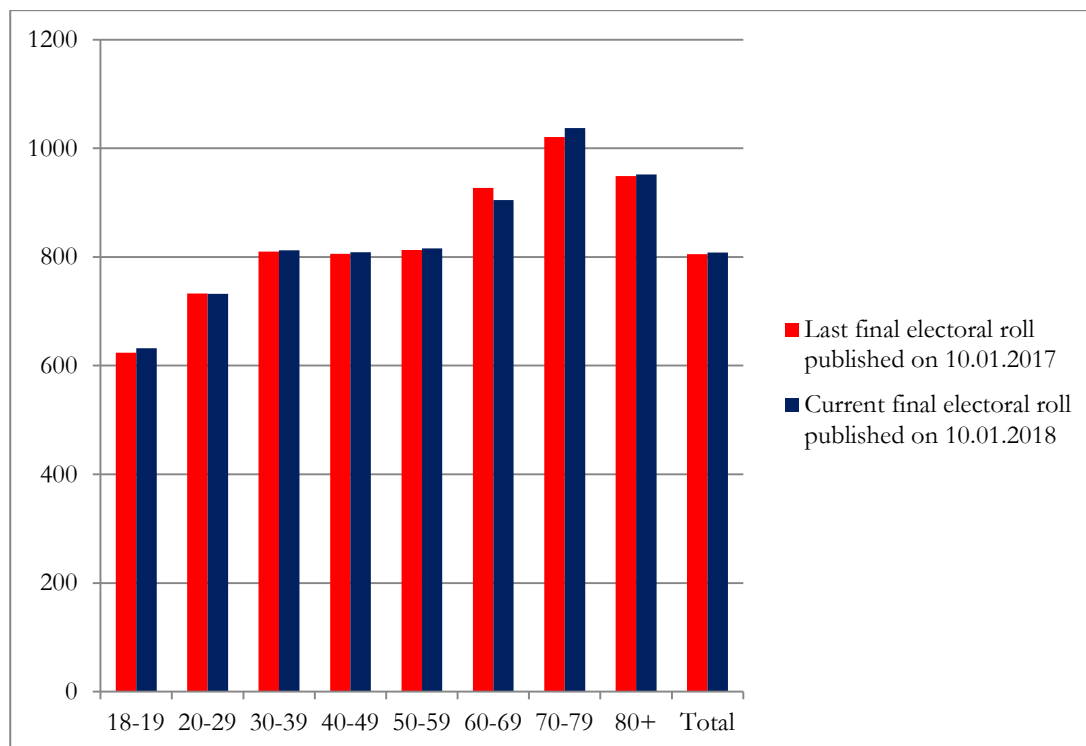
