ECI's SPECIAL DRIVE FOR ENROLMENT OF YOUNG VOTERS

Dated: 16th June,2017

- **1.** An Special Drive will be carried out in all 70 Assembly Constituencies of the NCT of Delhi w.e.f. 01st July,2017 to 31st July,2017 in accordance with the directions of the Election Commission of India.
- 2. Objective of the Special Drive is **of enrolment of eligible young electors particularly in 18-19 years age group (extendable upto 21 years of age) as on 01.01.2017**. Number of 18-19 years age group electors registered in the electoral roll of the NCT of Delhi is 110639 as on the date of final publication of electoral roll i.e. 10th January,2017. Presently, there are 175197 electors of 18-19 years age group electors registered in the electoral roll of the NCT of Delhi. The shortfall in this category of electors is still very high considering that more than 6 lakhs persons are projected of this age group as per Census Population Data-2011.
- **3.** Booth Level Officer (BLO) will conduct door to door visit during the Special Drive to the households where no elector of 18-19 years age group is yet registered. The BLO will have BLO Regisiter with them and any person can also check their existing electoral details from the BLO Register. Subsequent follow up action by filing corresponding application form (Form-6 for inclusion of name, Form-7 for deletion of name, Form-8 for correction of existing details and Form-8A for change of address within the same Assembly Consitiuency) may be taken by the elector as per his convenience.
- **4.** Special Camps will be organized on 9th July,2017 (Sunday) and 23rd July,2017 (Sunday) at every polling station under the supervision of the respective District Election Officer /District Magistrate. During these camps, the citizens can check their names in the existing electoral roll and also submit their Form-6 (for inclusion of name) or Form-8 (for correction in existing details) at the polling station itself

- **5.** During the period of Special Drive, Special Camps will be organized in Senior Secondary Schools on 13th July,2017 (Thursday) & 14th July,2017 (Friday) and Colleges/ITIs/ Polytechnic Colleges on 27th July,2017 (Thursday) & 28th July,2017 (Friday) for submission of Form-6 of left out electors of 18-21 years age group.
- **6.** During this Special Drive, another focus area will be removal of name of expired electors. Any family member/relative can file Form-7 along with a copy of death certificate for deletion of name of the deceased elector.
- **7.** Disposal of Forms will be done within a period of 30 days from the receipt of the Forms. Disposal of Form-7 (other than death cases), Form-8 and Form-8A received during the period of Special Drive will be done only after the Special Drive.
- **8.** As additional services to voters and citizens, Mobile App developed by the Election Commission of India can be downloaded from the website of the Election Commission of India (www.eci.nic.in). A user can fill the Form, track the status of Form, make electoral search etc through this mobile app. REMEMBER that mobile app available on the Commission's website shall only be entertained.
