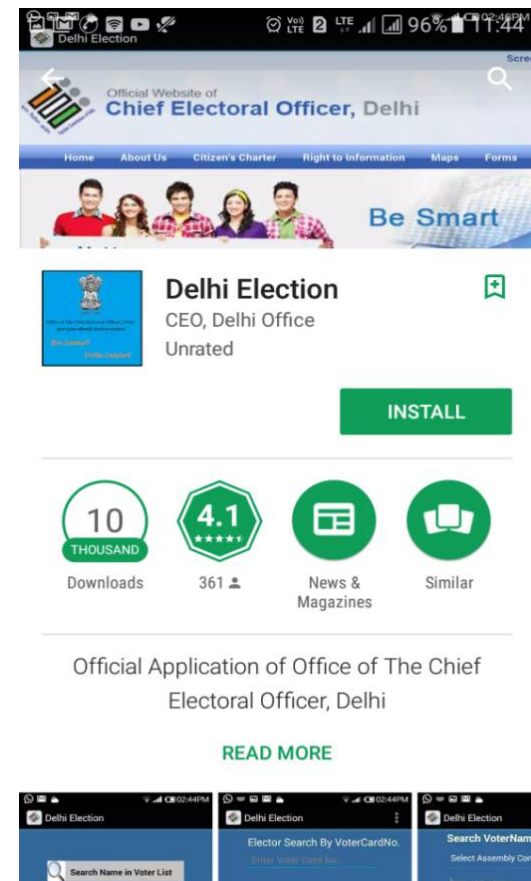

- **location/ GPS turned on, in your device settings (to use 'Navigate to your polling station' feature.**

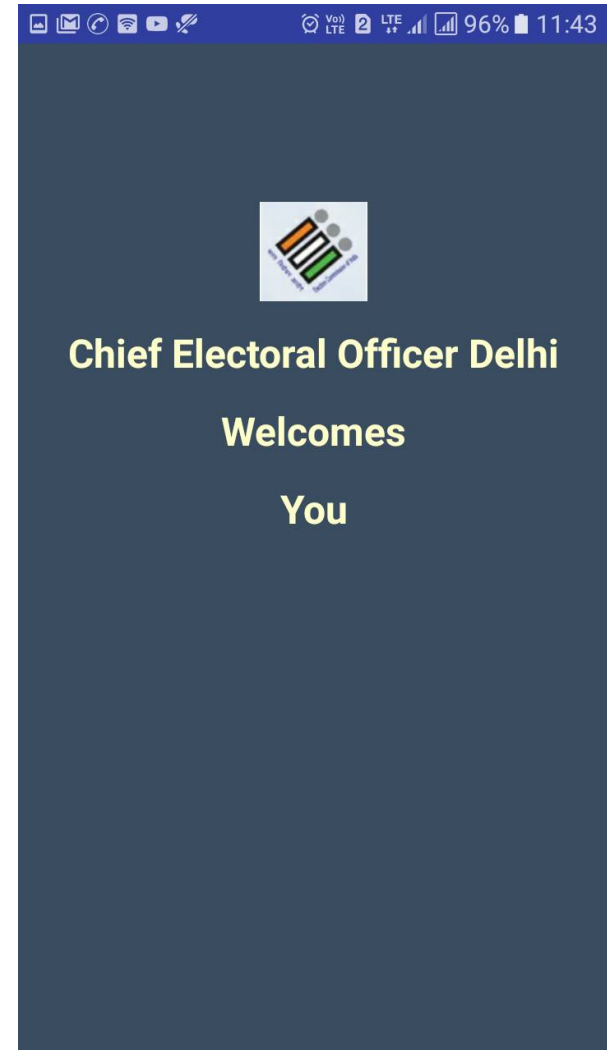
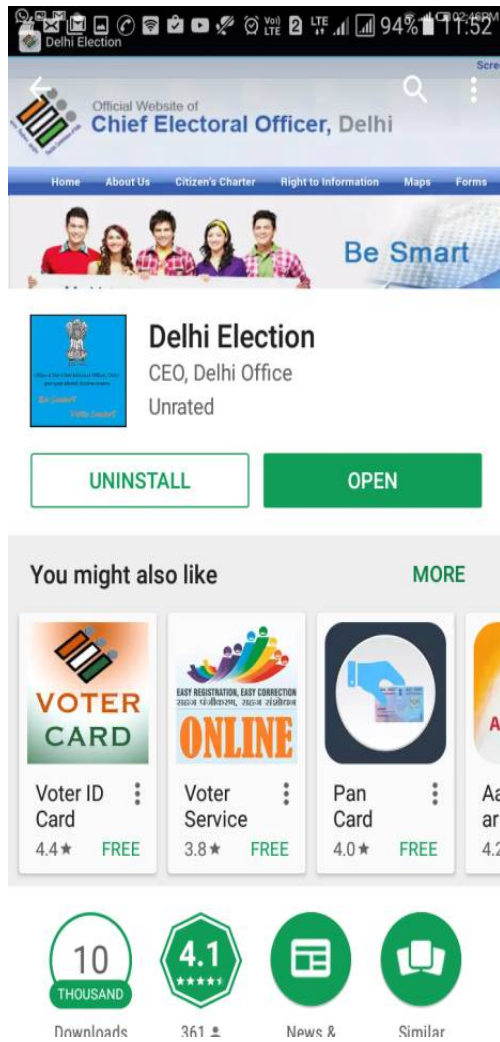


# How to download/install Delhi Election application

- Click 'Install' button to download & install application.


