**NOTICE**

Election Commission vide notification dated 18.03.2019 has notified Lok Sabha general elections in various States and Union Territories. The 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of Lok Sabha General Elections shall be held on 18.04.2019 in various States including UP.

Subsequently, Chief Electoral Officer vide letter No. CEO/COE /102(48) /2019/624-25 dated 16.04.2019 addressed to Secretary-cum-Commissioner (Labour) has mentioned that all establishments, factories, other business establishments in Delhi should ensure that the electors residing in district of Uttar Pradesh (Bijnor, Amroha, Hapur, Bulandshahar, Aligarh, Hathras, Mathura, Agra and Etah) and working in their establishments should be granted paid holiday on 18.04.2019 (Thursday), the day of poll in the above mentioned districts to enable them to cast their vote.

Accordingly, all such employers of Industrial Establishments/Factories /Shops and Commercial Establishments mentioned hereinabove shall grant one day paid holiday to their employees who are electors in the above mentioned districts of Uttar Pradesh which are going to poll on 18.04.2019, so that they can cast their vote in their respective constituencies.
