PRESS NOTE

1. Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2020 as qualifying date, has been completed in NCT of Delhi with final publication of electoral roll on 06.01.2020. The objective of the Special Summary Revision – 2020 was to get fresh enrolment i.e. who have attained age of 18+ as on qualifying date i.e. 01.01.2020 and giving opportunities for correction in electors particulars and also to invite objections against any wrong inclusion in the Electoral Roll. Special Summary Revision-2020 was carried out as per the schedule prescribed by the ECI as under:

2. MAIN HIGHLIGHTS OF SPECIAL SUMMARY REVISION-2020:-

- a. An Elector Verification Programme was carried out as pre-revision activity to the Special Summary Revision-2020 during the period from 01.09.2019 to 31.10.2019 where in house to house visits were also conducted by the Booth Level Officers (BLOs) for identification and removal of the dead/permanently shifted electors and inclusion of left out unenrolled/prospective electors in NCT of Delhi
- b. Total 2,47,950 electors have been added and names of 60,848 electors have been deleted from the electoral roll. Accordingly, 1,87,102 net electors have increased in the electoral roll during the Special Summary Revision-2020.
- c. Total electors in the final electoral roll of the NCT of Delhi as on 06.01.2020 are 1,46,92,136 which is 9,96,845 (7.27 %) more than the total electors of 1,36,95,291 in the last final electoral roll published on 18.01.2019.
- d. Gender Ratio of the electors registered in the final electoral roll has increased to 824 as compared to the gender ratio of 812 in the final roll last published on 18.01.2019.
- e. A detailed exercise of rationalization of polling stations was also carried out as pre-revision activity to the Special Summary Revision-2020 in Sep-Oct, 2019 to decongest the existing polling stations and merge the polling stations having less no. of voters. As a result of this exercise, the number of polling stations has decreased from 13816 to 13750 and number of polling locations has decreased from 2700 to 2689, which would result in lesser no. of Manpower to be required during forthcoming Assembly Elections-2020.

3. **SVEEP**:- Various SVEEP activities for awareness of prospective electors w.r.t. 01.01.2020 as qualifying date were organized during Special Summary Revision which includes announcement in Delhi Metro, Advertisement through print media, FM Radio jingles, Nukkad Nataks etc.
