I am directed to inform you that Special camps for voter registration/awareness are to be organized in Hospitals (both Government & Private) & Dispensaries on **27-12-2019, 28-12-2019, 30-12-2019 & 31-12-2019 (04 days)** for the upcoming Delhi Legislative Assembly Election 2020. Following activities are required to be made in the Special Camps:

- Display of Standee/Canopy till the completion of the Vidhan Sabha Election 2020.
- Announcement through PA system in the hospital for at least 03 times a day, if possible.
- For large gathering/participation of general public in the special camps, the hospital administration will place notice on their notice board/reception area.

You are therefore, requested to direct all the concerned Hospitals (both Government & Private) & Dispensaries to provide suitable space on prominent place (if possible at Reception) in the Hospital/Dispensary for display of Standee/Canopy for awareness of voters and a counter for Election Staff for inclusion of fresh voters including PwD voters in the Electoral Roll as well as casting of votes during Poll day.
