### **Voter Awareness Campaign in Low Voter Turnout areas in Badarpur Assembly Constituency**

In the line of conducting Special Awareness programmes in 30 Assembly Constituencies in NCT of Delhi, where a considerable large number of voters did not turn up for voting in Lok Sabha Election -2019, voter awareness programmes were conducted in various locations of Badarpur Assembly Constituency Area (AC-53).

It is worthwhile to mention that a total of 1,39,196 voters out of 3,08,118 registered voters from Badarpur Assembly Constituency did not cast their vote during Lok Sabha Elections- 2019.

The campaign with a theme "Badhayenge Loktantra Ki Shaan, EVM-VVPAT Se Voting Hai Bahut Asaan, Hamara Vote Hamara Abhiyan" was organized with an aspect of making the voters familiar with the functioning of EVM-VVPAT. The election officials showcased the Machines to the voters can familiarize themselves with the process of using EVM-VVPAT. The voters were given hands on demonstration of the machine. The Voters especially women and girl voters keenly participated in the demonstration process and cleared their doubts with the help of Election Officials. The Election Team also informed the gathering about the facilities provided by CEO, Delhi to the PwD, senior citizen voters.
