



The nature of disposal of such seizer material?	<p>As far as disposal of cash of seizure is concerned, A Committee Comprising of three Officers at the District Level is formed, which suo-moto examine each case of seizure made and where the committee finds that no FIR/Complaint has been filed against the seizure, or where the seizure is not linked with any other political parties or any Election Campaign etc., as per Standard Operating Procedure, it takes, Immediate step to order release of such cash, all seized matter are released with a 07 days of poll, if no FIR is filed, or, if not handed over to Income Tax Deptt.</p> <p>If the release of cash is more than Rs. 10 Lakhs, the Nodal Officer of Income Tax Deptt. is kept informed before the release is effected.</p> <p>The Illegal liquor seized under Delhi Excise Act- 2009 in connection with Delhi Legislative Assembly Election-2020 has been deposited in concerned Police Stations as case property. Disposal of liquor is under process as per provision of Chapter IX, Rule 132, Delhi Excise Rules.</p>






