The Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of Delhi, Dr. Ranbir Singh today informed that Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2023 as qualifying date, has commenced in all 70 Assembly Constituencies of the NCT of Delhi with draft publication of electoral roll on 09.11.2022.

The CEO, Delhi also informed that, as a mark of national launch of SSR-2023, Chief Election Commissioner Sh. Rajiv Kumar and Election Commissioner Sh. Anup Chandra Pandey participated in specific events at Pune, Maharashtra. The Hon'ble Commission participated in cycle rally started from Balewadi stadium Pune to launch the SSR and inspired youth of the whole country to enroll as voter and vote in every election. Eminent personalities like Film Director & Producer Nagraj Manjule & Olympian Shooter Anjali Bhagwat also participated to motivate voters. An exhibition on voter awareness messages was inaugurated at Savitri Bai Phule University. The Hon'ble Commission interacted with nodal officers of all Voter Awareness Forums of Pune at Hingewadi to take their feedback and to request them to address the problem of urban apathy through voter education.

Special Summary Revision-2023 will be carried out in NCT of Delhi in accordance with the schedule prescribed by the ECI as under:

Dr. Singh further said that the primary objective of the Special Summary Revision – 2023 is to include newly eligible and left out voters w.r.t.01.01.2023 i.e. who have completed or will be completing age of 18 years on or before date 01.01.2023. Another objective for the Special Summary Revision-2023 is to give opportunities for correction in electors' particulars and also to invite objections against any wrong inclusion in the Electoral Roll.

Another provision has been made from Special Summary Revision – 2023. An eligible Citizen, who is going to attain the age of eighteen years on any of the subsequent qualifying dates in the year **2023**, that is to say, the **1st April, 2023, the 1st July 2023 or the 1st October, 2023**, may also file his or her claim for inclusion of his or her name in the roll, in Form-6, in advance, starting from today and his/ her voter card would be issued after the relevant qualifying date, CEO, Delhi added.

The CEO further informed that AC wise draft electoral roll is available on the website of the department www.ceodelhi.gov.in. Electoral Rolls are also available at Designated Locations (At all polling station locations) whose AC wise list can be seen at our website.

The CEO, Delhi also said that a person, whose name has been deleted from the electoral roll wrongfully can file an appeal under Section 24 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 within the prescribed period of 15 days to the District Election Officer against the deletion of his/her name or submit Form-6 for inclusion of his/her name in the electoral roll any time during summary revision of electoral roll.

CEO Delhi further informed that a Human Chain Awareness Campaign was organized at Rajghat to create awareness about SSR-2023 in which about 700 volunteers of Nehru Yuvak Kendra and Civil Defence participated in full strength. He also informed that a Special Session of Chunav Pathshala has also been organized in each Polling Booth today where BLOs read out the draft roll to Booth Level Agents and other members. All District Election Officers have also attended the Special Session at one Chunav Pathshala in their respective districts. A meeting has also been organized in District/AC level today with the Campus Ambassadors and Nodal officers of their Electoral Literacy Clubs and Voter Awareness Forums.

CEO, Delhi informed that as a part of the SSR activity, Outdoor media campaign through Bus Queue Shelters, Unipoles, Digital Screens, Hoardings, Electronic Media Campaign through Radio Jingle on FM Channels, Phone in Programme, Awareness Campaign through display of SVEEP creatives on public utility bills, SMSs to mobile users of Delhi under CSR Scheme through TERM, Services of NGOs, CSOs to increase Voter Registration, Special Rath/vehicle, Public Notice and Advertisement in Hindi, English and vernacular languages, Banners, Scroll running on DTC Buses, Website of Delhi Govt., Awareness campaign to youth through online conferences, Extensive use of Social Media platforms, Display of Banners/Creatives in ATMs/Mother dairy booths/ etc., Sports event, Appeal letter of CEO Delhi, Stall at Delhi Haat, ITPO, IHC, Gymkhana

Club, CSOI, ECI Boundary, competitions in Delhi (Poem, Video making and slogan), etc. have been started in Delhi.

Dr. Singh has emphasized for the following points:

- 1. All new applicants attaining the age of 18 years by 01.01.2023, please apply in Form-6.**
- 2. All prospective voters completing 18 years w.r.t. qualifying dates 01.04.2023, 01.07.2023 & 01.10.2023, please apply in Form-6 in advance.**
- 3. Apply for correction/replacement of EPIC/Shifting/Marking of PwD through Form-8.**
- 4. Never have name in the voter list at more than one location. Apply for deletion of multiple entry(ies) in Form-7.**

 - II. Download prescribed Form from these Websites or Obtain from any Voter Centre and submit at Voter Centre of your Assembly Constituency or your Polling Station Location whose list is available on www.ceodelhi.gov.in.
