1. Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2022 as qualifying date, has commenced in all 70 Assembly Constituencies of the NCT of Delhi with draft publication of electoral roll on 01.11.2021. Special Summary Revision-2022 will be carried out in accordance with the schedule prescribed by the ECI as under:-

- 2. Apply for correction in details of EPIC through Form-8
- 3. Never have name in the voter list at more than one location. Apply for deletion of multiple entry (ies) in Form-7
