### PRESS NOTE

1. Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2023 as qualifying date, has commenced in all 70 Assembly Constituencies of the NCT of Delhi with draft publication of electoral roll on 09.11.2022. Special Summary Revision-2023 will be carried out in accordance with the schedule prescribed by the ECI as under:-

The primary objective of the Special Summary Revision – 2023 is to include newly eligible and left out voters w.r.t. 01.01.2023 i.e. who have completed or will be completing age of 18 years on or before date 01.01.2023. Another objective for the Special Summary Revision-2023 is to give opportunities for correction in electors' particulars and also to invite objections against any wrong inclusion in the Electoral Roll.

Another provision has been made from Special Summary Revision – 2023. An eligible Citizen, who is going to attain the age of eighteen years on any of the subsequent qualifying dates in the year **2023**, that is to say, the **1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023, the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023 or the 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2023**, may also file his or her claim for inclusion of his or her name in the roll, in Form-6, in advance, starting from the date of notice and the same shall be considered and decided in the respective quarter of the year with reference to the respective qualifying date.

A person, whose name has been deleted from the electoral roll wrongfully can file an appeal under Section 24 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 within the prescribed period of 15 days to the District Election Officer against the deletion of his/her name or submit Form-6 for inclusion of his/her name in the electoral roll any time during summary revision of electoral roll.

**APPEAL**

- 1. All new applicants attaining the age of 18 years by 01.01.2023, 01.04.2023, 01.07.2023 & 01.10.2023, please apply in Form-6**
- 2. Apply for correction/replacement of EPIC/Shifting/Marking of PwD through Form-8**
- 3. Never have name in the voter list at more than one location. Apply for deletion of multiple entry (ies) in Form-7**
