## NO VOTER TO BE LEFT BEHIND

### PRESS NOTE

1. Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2023 as qualifying date, has been completed in NCT of Delhi with final publication of electoral roll on 05.01.2023. The primary objective of the Special Summary Revision – 2023 was to get fresh enrolment i.e. who have attained age of 18 or 18+ as on qualifying date i.e. 01.01.2023 and to give opportunities for correction in electors particulars and also to invite objections against any wrong inclusion in the Electoral Roll. Special Summary Revision-2023 was carried out as per the schedule prescribed by the Election Commission of India as under:

Another provision was made starting from this from Special Summary Revision – 2023. An eligible Citizen, who is going to attain the age of eighteen years on any of the subsequent qualifying dates in the year **2023**, that is to say, the **1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023, the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023 or the 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2023**, may also file his or her claim for inclusion of his or her name in the roll, in Form-6, in advance. The same shall be considered and decided in the respective quarter of the year with reference to the respective qualifying date. Total No. of 4,555 prospective electors have applied for registration in the electoral rolls of NCT of Delhi during SSR-2023.

## 2. MAIN HIGHLIGHTS OF SPECIAL SUMMARY REVISION-2023:-

- a. During the period of Special Summary Revision-2023, net 85,545 electors comprising of 42,275 male, 43,178 female electors and 92 third gender electors have been added. Detail is as under:-

- b. The total electors in final electoral roll published on 05.01.2023 are 1,47,76,301 comprising of 80,38,676 male, 67,36,470 female and 1,155 third gender electors whereas as per the previous final electoral roll published on 05.01.2022, total electors were 1,48,99,159 comprising of 81,38,593 male, 67,59,534 female and 1,032 third gender electors.
- c. Gender Ratio of the electors registered in this final electoral roll has increased to 838 as compared to the gender ratio of 831 in the previous final roll last published on 05.01.2022.
- d. A detailed exercise of rationalization of polling stations was also carried out as pre-revision activity to the Special Summary Revision-2023 in Sep-Oct, 2022 to decongest the existing polling stations and merge the polling stations having less no. of voters. As a result of this exercise, the number of polling stations has decreased from 13820 to 13649 and number of polling locations has decreased from 2684 to 2656.
- e. SVEEP activities were carried out during SSR-2023 to create awareness and motivate eligible citizens to register as voters. Multimedia campaign through Outdoor Media/Electronic Media such as FM, Internet and Digital Screens was launched to create awareness about voter registration with special focus on prospective voters in 17+ age category. Outreach activities were organized such as Nukkad Nataks, Munadi etc. by all districts. Mega events such as dance performance by State Icon Ms. Alaknanda Dasgupta, sports events, human chain etc. were organized. For youth and prospective voters in 17+ age category video making competition, slogan writing competition, poem competition were organized.
