## PRESS NOTE

1. Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2022 as qualifying date, has been completed in NCT of Delhi with final publication of electoral roll on 05.01.2022. The primary objective of the Special Summary Revision – 2022 was to get fresh enrolment i.e. who have attained age of 18 or 18+ as on qualifying date i.e. 01.01.2022 and to give opportunities for correction in electors particulars and also to invite objections against any wrong inclusion in the Electoral Roll. Special Summary Revision-2022 was carried out as per the schedule prescribed by the Election Commission of India as under:

## 2. MAIN HIGHLIGHTS OF SPECIAL SUMMARY REVISION-2022:-

- a. During the period of Special Summary Revision-2022, Net **1,03,610** electors comprising of **50,562** male, **52,964** female electors and **84** third gender electors have been added. Detail is as under:-

- b. The total electors in final electoral roll published on 05.01.2022 are **1,48,99,159** comprising of **81,38,593** male, **67,59,534** female and **1,032** third gender electors whereas as per the previous final electoral roll published on 15.01.2021, total electors were **1,48,98,069** comprising of **81,58,180** male, **67,38,976** female and **913** third gender electors.
- c. Gender Ratio of the electors registered in the final electoral roll has increased to 831 as compared to the gender ratio of 826 in the previous final roll last published on 15.01.2021.
- d. A detailed exercise of rationalization of polling stations was also carried out as pre-revision activity to the Special Summary Revision-2022 in Sep-Oct, 2021 to decongest the existing polling stations and merge the polling stations having less no. of voters. As a result of this exercise, the number of polling stations has increased from 13789 to 13820 and number of polling locations has decreased marginally from 2690 to 2684.
- e. SVEEP:- Various SVEEP activities for awareness of prospective electors w.r.t. 01.01.2022 as qualifying date were carried out during Special Summary Revision which includes announcement in Delhi Metro, Advertisement through print media, FM Radio jingles, Nukkad Nataks, Display of Banner at prominent locations, Munadi etc.
