- **Sh. P. Krishnamurthy, Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), Delhi holds a meeting with all National Political Parties regarding Special Summary Revision (SSR) of Electoral Rolls w.r.t. 01.01.2024 as the qualifying date;**

The Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), Delhi, Sh. P. Krishnamurthy today convened a meeting with all Recognised Political Parties regarding Special Summary Revision (SSR) of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2024 as a qualifying date.

Representatives from the Indian National Congress (INC), Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) and Bhartiya Janta Party (BJP) have attended the meeting.

CEO, Delhi informed the representatives of all political parties that the draft publication of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2024 as a qualifying date and Special Summary Revision will be start on 27.10.2023 and final publication of Electoral Roll will be on 05.01.2024. Sh. P. Krishnamurthy further informed that the primary objective of this SSR is to include newly eligible voters who have completed or will be completing the age of 18 on or before date 01.01.2024 as well as all left out electors. Another objective for the Special Summary Revision is to give opportunities for correction in electors' particulars and to invite objections against any wrong inclusion in the Electoral Roll.

Sh. P. Krishnamurthy, during the meeting, also shared the schedule and details of the ensuing Special Summary Revision (SSR) of Electoral Rolls (with reference to 01.01.2024 as the qualifying date) with political parties, which is as follows:

Sh. P. Krishnamurthy briefed the political parties about the roles and responsibilities of their Booth Level Agents (BLAs) who are appointed by them for each polling station to coordinate with the concerned BLOs for inclusion of left-out eligible citizens and deletion of dead or permanently shifted electors. He further requested all representatives of political parties to ensure that BLAs should perform their role properly in the interest of improving the purity and updation of Electoral Roll. Booth Level Agents (BLA) should scrutinize the draft electoral roll of all parts and share the feedback to the concerned BLO for further necessary action/ improvement of electoral roll.

CEO informed that necessary measures will be taken to spread awareness during the forthcoming SSR to encourage young electors including female electors to enroll themselves as voters via various platforms viz. Social Media /Digital Media/TV/Radio/Newspapers etc.
