The Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of Delhi, Sh. P. Krishnamurthy today informed that Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2024 as qualifying date, has commenced in all 70 Assembly Constituencies of the NCT of Delhi with draft publication of electoral roll on 27.10.2023.

Special Summary Revision-2024 will be carried out in NCT of Delhi in accordance with the schedule prescribed by the ECI as under:

Sh. P. Krishnamurthy further said that the primary objective of the Special Summary Revision – 2024 is to include newly eligible and left out voters w.r.t. 01.01.2024 i.e. who have completed or will be completing age of 18 years on or before date 01.01.2024. Another objective for the Special Summary Revision-2024 is to give opportunities for correction in electors' particulars and also to invite objections against any wrong inclusion in the Electoral Roll.

CEO further stated that another provision has been made from Special Summary Revision – 2024. An eligible Citizen, who is going to attain the age of eighteen years on any of the subsequent qualifying dates in the year 2024, that is to say, the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2024, the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024 or the 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2024, may also file his or her claim for inclusion of his or her name in the roll, in Form-6, in advance, starting from today and his/ her voter card would be issued after the relevant qualifying date, CEO, Delhi added.

The CEO further informed that AC wise draft electoral roll is available on the website of the department [www.ceodelhi.gov.in](http://www.ceodelhi.gov.in). Electoral Rolls are also available at Designated Locations (At all polling station locations) whose AC wise list can be seen at our website.

List of claims & objections in Forms-9, 10, 11, 11A & 11 B is also available on the website of CEO, Delhi so that citizens are able to see the list and lodge objections with ERO concerned.

The CEO, Delhi also said that a person, whose name has been deleted from the electoral roll wrongfully can file an appeal under Section 24 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 within the prescribed period of 15 days to the District Election Officer against the deletion of his/her name or submit Form-6 for inclusion of his/her name in the electoral roll any time during summaryrevision of electoral roll.

CEO, Delhi informed that as a part of the SSR activity, Outdoor media campaign will be carried out in different part of city through Bus Queue Shelters, Unipoles, Hoardings, Electronic Media Campaign through RadioJingle on FM Channels etc..

CEO, Delhi has emphasized for the following points:

- 1. All new applicants attaining the age of 18 years by 01.01.2024, please apply in Form-6.**
- 2. All prospective voters completing 18 years w.r.t. qualifying dates 01.04.2024, 01.07.2024 & 01.10.2024, please apply in Form-6 in advance.**
- 3. Apply for correction/replacement of EPIC/Shifting/Marking of PwD through Form-8.**
- 4. Never have name in the electoral roll in more than one constituency or in any constituency more than once. It is a punishable offence u/s 17 & 18 of the Representation of People Act, 1950. Apply for deletion of multiple entry (ies) in Form-7.**
