PUBLIC NOTICE

It has come to the notice of this office that several clusters/government colonies/residential buildings have been relocated due to various reasons including redevelopment, removal of encroachment etc and the occupants of these clusters/government colonies/residential buildings have also been shifted/ relocated to other areas of Delhi.

All registered voters of such shifted clusters/government colonies/residential buildings are hereby informed that only a person who is ordinarily resident in a given address can enroll himself/herself as an elector of that constituency.

Accordingly, all registered voters of such clusters/government colonies/residential buildings are hereby requested to get themselves registered in the electoral roll at the new place by filing application in **Form-8** and get their names deleted from the previous place of residence by declaring their previous EPIC details in Form-8 itself.

It is also informed that the registered voters of all such relocated clusters/government colonies/residential buildings will be deleted by the Electoral Registration Officer concerned after following due process as the voters have ceased to be ordinarily resident in such relocated cases.

Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls is going on and last date of receiving claims and objections is 09.12.2023. All registered voters of such clusters/government colonies/residential buildings are requested to apply in Form-8 either using **Online** at Voters' Portal <https://voters.eci.gov.in>/Voter Helpline App/Saksham App (for Divyangjan) or **Offline** at Voter Centre of their Assembly Constituency or their Polling Station Location whose list is available on www.ceodelhi.gov.in

Having more than one entry in the electoral roll is a punishable offence u/s 17 & 18 of the Representation of People Act, 1950.
