- **The special camps organised at all polling stations on 2nd & 3rd December in National Capital Territory of Delhi to facilitate enrolment of voters**
- **There are only six days left for Special Summary Revision, therefore people must enroll themselves at the earliest. Last date for enrolment/filing of claims & objection is 9th December, 2023 - CEO**

The Chief Electoral Office, Delhi organised Special Camps on 2nd & 3rd December, 2023 in all polling stations across Delhi to provide every possible assistance like searching the name in the voter list, enrolment for Voter ID card, correction in voter ID, deletion of name, etc. to the general public. This was informed by the Chief Electoral Officer, Delhi Sh. P. Krishnamurthy. There are a total of 13,637 polling stations set up across the National Capital.

All District Election Officers (DMs) also visited these camps within their jurisdiction to see the arrangements made in these Special Camps. Also, the numerous teams of O/o CEO, Delhi simultaneously inspected these camps. More than 13000 Booth Level Officers (BLOs) were also deputed in these camps.

This step towards voter education and facilitation will not only help the electors to get all necessary assistance, but will also give wings to the vision of 'No Voter To Be Left Behind', CEO said.

A new provision has been already made in Special Summary Revision – 2024 as follows:

An eligible Citizen, who is going to attain the age of eighteen years on any of the subsequent qualifying dates in the year 2024, that is to say, the 1st April, 2024, the 1st July 2024 or the 1st

October, 2024, may also file his or her claim for inclusion of his or her name in the roll, in Form-6, in advance, his/ her voter card would be issued after the relevant qualifying date, CEO Delhi added.

The Chief Electoral Officer, Delhi, Sh. P Krishnamurthy informed that, earlier, Special Camps were also organised on 04th and 05th November at all polling stations of Delhi. Last date for the enrollment/filing claims & objection is **09.12.2023** therefore only six days are left for all citizens to get enrolled.

The CEO also emphasized the need to adopt on-line mode of availing electoral services since they are quick, efficient, convenient and safer. He urged all Delhi residents over the age of 18 to download the Voter Helpline app, which will provide them access to all electoral services via their mobile phones. Draft Rolls are displayed in all polling stations as well as on www.ceodelhi.gov.in where citizens can check their names in the voter list.

The CEO advised every citizen to download ECI's VoterHelpline App/ Saksham App (Divyang). Online application can also be filed on ECI's portal <https://voters.eci.gov.in>. For any queries or assistance, citizens can call the election help line No. 1950.

CEO further informed that, those who are not internet-savvy can file applications off-line by visiting their Polling Station or Voter Center. For more information, citizens can visit www.ceodelhi.gov.in website.
