Successful Completion of the Sixth Voting Phase in Delhi's all 7 Parliamentary Constituencies

Enhanced Security and Monitoring Ensure Smooth Voting in Delhi, Records 58.70% Voter Turnout in the Sixth Phase of Elections in Delhi

Despite the Intense Heat Chief Electoral Officer Sh. P. Krishnamurthy Commends Delhi's Enthusiastic Voter Participation

New Delhi, May 25, 2024

The Chief Electoral Officer of Delhi, Shri P. Krishnamurthy, has announced that the sixth phase of voting in all seven parliamentary constituencies of Delhi was completed peacefully and successfully today. Citizens from all sections of society participated enthusiastically, exercising their democratic right to vote. Despite the intense heat, 58.70% (tentative) voter turnout was recorded.

Voting started at 7 in the morning and continued until 6 in the evening. To ensure the security and integrity of the electoral process, the Chief Electoral Officer of Delhi, Shri P. Krishnamurthy, supervised the operations with live monitoring of 2891 sensitive polling stations through webcasting. The Delhi CEO Headquarters has setup a control room to continuously monitor webcasts from sensitive stations, ensuring real-time monitoring and immediate response to any issues.

Sh. P. Krishnamurthy also informed that- To tackle the intense heat, proper shading was arranged at all polling booths, providing relief to voters as they exercised their rights today. The well-organised pink booths, PwD booths and model booths were particularly noteworthy, attracting voters' attention and contributing to the final turnout.

Prominent personalities, including President Smt. Droupadi Murmu and Vice President Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar, participated in the voting process in Delhi, setting an example for citizens and adding to the festive atmosphere of the election.
