No eligible citizen to be left out while no ineligible person to be included in the Electoral Roll

PRESS NOTE

During a Press conference held by AAP on 08.09.2026, an issue has been raised by the party alleging inclusion of name of Shri Raghav Chadha, MP (Rajya Sabha) in the electoral rolls of Delhi in AC-39 (Rajinder Nagar) without following due procedure.

2. General Electors of NCT of Delhi and other stake holders are hereby informed that name of any elector is added, deleted & modified in the electoral roll only on the basis of Form-6, 7 & 8 respectively. These Forms are disposed by the Electoral Registration Officers in accordance with the provisions laid down under "The Representation of People Act, 1950" & "The Registration of Electors Rules, 1960" and instruction of Election Commission of India. Forms can be submitted by any elector at any time during the year.

3. Presently, draft roll in Delhi has been published on 31.08.2026 on the basis of Enumeration Forms submitted by the Electors (whose names were present in the electoral roll prior to start of SIR) to their respective BLOs during Enumeration phase i.e. 30.06.2026 to 17.08.2026. Draft list is available on the website of CEO, Delhi for viewing/downloading at following link:-

4. Draft Photo Electoral Roll can be inspected at the offices of the Electoral Registration Officer/Assistant Electoral Registration Officer and with all the Booth Level Officers (BLOs) of Assembly Constituencies and also at all the Designated Locations (Polling Stations).

In case any elector was unable to submit their filled-in enumeration forms within the specified time (30th June to 17th Aug 2026), or having claim of being genuine elector, they may file Form 6 along with the prescribed Declaration Form for inclusion during the claims and objections period (31.08.2026 to 30.09.2026).

The claims and objections can be filed in following forms:

- Form 6: Application for enrolment of new elector alongwith declaration & supportive documents.
- Form 6A: Application for addition by Overseas Indian

- Form 7: Application for objecting proposed inclusion or seeking deletion of existing entry
- Form 8: Shifting of residence within or outside constituency by existing elector, application for correction in particulars, replacement of EPIC without correction and marking of PWD elector, alongwith declaration & supportive documents.

Application forms may be submitted physically to the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO), Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (AERO), Booth Level Officers (BLO) and also at Designated Locations (polling stations).

5. Attention is invited to detailed guidelines of ECI for Special Intensive Revision dated 14.05.2026 with special reference to para 11 (a) on Preparation of Electoral Roll at the time of Final Publication, which reads as “ERO will ensure that the Final roll is a single updated roll (draft roll plus supplements prepared during SIR), **in which all the additions made during SIR period will come with SI. No. in continuation after the last entry of the draft roll** and all the modifications and deletions carried out during SIR shall be reflected in the updated roll against SI. No. of such modified and deleted entries”.

Accordingly, if a draft roll of a part contains electors from 01 to 812, then addition supplementary electoral roll to be published on 04.11.2026 of that particular part will start from serial no. 813 onwards. The electoral roll was freezed on 16.06.2026 for preparation of SIR and remained in frozen state till 31.08.2026 i.e. date of draft publication. **During this period, approx. 2.14 lakh Forms-6 (besides Form-7 & 8) were submitted by the electors. During the period of claims & objections, another 25,011 Forms-6 have been submitted by the electors in 08 days (upto 07.9.2026) for inclusion of their names in the final electoral rolls.**

6. All Forms-6 submitted by electors for inclusion of their names during Pre-SIR period or during period of claims & objections are under process alongwith Forms-7 & 8. Once the Forms are approved, addition, deletion & modification will be reflected in the Electoral Database as the case may be. Additions of electors will be published as Supplementary list on 04.11.2026 whereas, modifications and deletions carried out during period of claims & objections of SIR shall be reflected in the updated roll against SI. No. of such modified and deleted entries” as per schedule of the Election Commission. EPIC No. in respect of new additions is generated by the system at time of approval of Forms. Physical EPIC will be delivered to the electors as per timelines of the Commission.

7. Attention is invited to detailed guidelines of ECI for Special Intensive Revision dated 14.05.2026 with special reference to para 6 (b) on Display of List of claims & objection which reads as “ list of all claims and objections received should also be put up on the website of the CEO so that citizens are able to see the list and lodge objections, if any, with the concerned ERO”. Accordingly, the same has been published on the website of CEO, Delhi.

8. As on today i.e. 08.09.2026 approx 700 Forms spread across all Assembly Constituencies have already been approved by the EROs for inclusion of names.

The Commission reiterates its firm commitment to a transparent, participative and inclusive revision process, ensuring that ‘**no eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll**’.
