PRESS NOTE

1. Election Commission of India has announced schedule of Special Intensive Revision in NCT of Delhi with main objective **"No eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll"** as given below:-

2. As per schedule of SIR, BLOs will conduct House to House enumeration from 30.6.2026 to 29.07.2026.
3. In this regard, a meeting was held with all recognized political parties under the Chairmanship of Chief Electoral Officer, Delhi on 24.06.2026.
4. Representatives of AAP, BJP, BSP, CPI(M) & INC attended the meeting. During the meeting CEO, Delhi informed them about the main objective of the Special Intensive Revision(SIR) **"No eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll"**.
5. Political parties were briefed about the important activities to be undertaken during Enumeration Phase. **Every existing elector, whose name exists in the electoral roll will be made available an Enumeration Form (in duplicate)** through BLOs.
6. Electors have to fill their details pertaining to last SIR in the Enumeration Form and return one copy of Enumeration Form to the BLO and obtain acknowledgement from the BLO.
7. Political parties were described about the procedure of filling Enumeration Form in different cases viz self mapping, progeny mapping, cases where no mapping could be done w.r.t. Electoral Roll 2002 and cases where married women have shifted to Delhi after last SIR and her name is not present in the electoral roll of last SIR in her native place.

8. Certain queries were raised by the political parties regarding the SIR. CEO, Delhi clarified the issues raised by the parties.
9. Political parties were requested to cooperate with the Election Machinery involved in the SIR at different level.
10. All political parties assured full cooperation, assistance and active involvement during the SIR-2026.
