PRESS BRIEFING

1. Election Commission of India in exercise of its powers under Article 324, Section 21 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 along with other applicable provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1950, has directed to begin the Special Intensive Revision(SIR) in the NCT of Delhi vide letter dated 14.05.2026 for the discharge of its constitutional mandate to protect the integrity of the electoral rolls.
2. Since many changes have occurred in the existing electoral roll due to frequent migration since the last SIR, which has resulted in electors getting registered in more than one place, non removal of dead voters, the Election Commission has announced the Special Intensive Revision. Main objective of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) is **"No eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll"**.
3. As per Article 326 of the Constitution Eligibility conditions of becoming an elector are as under:-
 - (i) Must be a citizen of India
 - (ii) Must be 18 years or older on the prescribed date
 - (iii) Must not be disqualified on ground of non-residence

As per Sec 16 of the Representation of People Act, 1950, A person shall be disqualified for registration in an electoral roll if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of India; or
- (b) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court; or
- (c) is for the time being disqualified from voting under the provisions of any law relating to corrupt practices and other offences in connection with elections.

4. Detailed schedule of the SIR is given below:-

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5. During SIR, BLOs will conduct House to House enumeration. **Every existing elector, whose name exists in the electoral roll will be made available an Enumeration Form (in duplicate)** through BLOs. Elector has to fill the enumeration form filling his/her required details and has to return one copy to the BLO.
 6. If BLO finds that any house is locked or closed at the time of enumeration, she/he shall slip the Enumeration Forms in the house and make at least three visits to collect filled up Forms.
 7. Provision will also be given to electors to fill Enumeration Form online during SIR period.
 8. For the convenience of General public, voter list of last Special Intensive Revision held in year 2002 in Delhi has been uploaded on the website of CEO, Delhi at the link https://www.ceodelhi.gov.in/ElectoralRoll_2002.aspx . Further, voters who have shifted in Delhi from other states after 2002 can find their names in ECI's Portal at <https://voters.eci.gov.in/searchInSIR/S2UA4DPDF-JK4QWODSE>
 9. All the Electors who are permanently staying in Delhi prior to 2002, can check their name in the voter list of 2002 available on the website of Chief Electoral Officer, Delhi and note down their details (**relative name, State Name, AC Name, AC Number, Part No, Sr No.**) as appearing in the voter list of 2002.

And in case if any elector has come from other State and settled in Delhi after 2002, their name will not appear in 2002 voter list of Delhi. In such case, electors are requested to search their details from www.voters.eci.gov.in and note down their details (**relative name, State Name, AC Name, AC Number, Part No, Sr No.**) as appearing in the voter list of **2002/2003/2005** (year of last SIR held in that particular State, as the case may be).
 10. Keep this information Handy for filling the details of electors/relatives of the last SIR in the Enumeration Form provided by BLO. No document is required to be submitted with the Enumeration Form.
 11. In such cases where the name of present elector does not appear in the voter list of last SIR, but the name of his **Parents/ Grand Parents** appears in the voter list of last SIR, he/she has to provide details of their parents/relatives in the Enumeration Form.
 12. For electors whose Enumeration Forms have not returned, BLO may identify a probable cause, such as Absent/Shifted/Death/Duplicate, based on an inquiry from the nearby electors and note the same.
 13. Rationalization of polling stations will also be undertaken during this period. ECI has reduced the limit of 1500 voter per polling station to 1200 voters per polling station for ease of electors during the poll.

14. All District Election Officers have been directed to gear up their election machinery for successful conduct of SIR. All necessary arrangements for Printing of Enumeration Forms, stationery etc have already been made in all districts. Appointment of BLOs & BLO Supervisors has also been made.
15. Helpdesks have also been setup at District as well as AC level for providing assistance to the general public during SIR.
16. A meeting with recognized political parties was also conducted on 19.05.2026. During the meeting, CEO, Delhi briefed them of the important points of law and procedures of the SIR and seek their cooperation. All parties agreed to extend full support during SIR.
17. As a pre-revision activity, presently mapping of electors of Year 2025 is being done vis-à-vis electors of Year 2002. Mapping of **62,44,045** electors i.e. **42.53** % have been done out of total **1,46,82,523** electors as on 26.05.2026.
18. 02 Videos have been prepared for awareness of general public regarding How to search their names in the electoral rolls of last SIR which are available on social media of CEO, Delhi.
