1. Election Commission of India on 14.05.2026 has announced schedule of Special Intensive Revision in NCT of Delhi with main objective **“No eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll”** as per details given below:-

3. As per Article 326 of the Constitution Eligibility conditions of becoming an elector are as under:-

- (i) Must be a citizen of India
- (ii) Must be 18 years or older on the prescribed date
- (iii) Must not be disqualified on ground of non-residence

As per Sec 16 of the Representation of People Act, 1950, A person shall be disqualified for registration in an electoral roll if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of India; or
- (b) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court; or
- (c) is for the time being disqualified from voting under the provisions of any law relating to corrupt practices and other offences in connection with elections.

As per Sec 19 of the Representation of People Act, 1950, Conditions of registration—
Subject to the foregoing provisions of this Part, every person who —

- (a) is not less than eighteen years of age on the qualifying date, and
- (b) is ordinarily resident in a constituency, shall be entitled to be registered in the electoral roll for that constituency.

3. Electoral Roll Profile of NCT of Delhi is as under:-

4. As per schedule of SIR, BLOs will visit House to House for distribution and collection of Enumeration Forms from 30.6.2026 to 29.07.2026. **Every existing elector, whose name exists in the electoral roll will be made available an Enumeration Form (in duplicate)** through BLOs.
5. If BLO finds that any house is locked or closed at the time of enumeration, he/she shall slip the Enumeration Forms in the house and make at least three visits to collect filled in Forms.
6. Electors have to fill their details pertaining to last SIR in the Enumeration Form and return one copy of filled in Enumeration Form to the BLO and obtain acknowledgement from the BLO. In case of Delhi, last SIR was conducted in the year 2002.
7. For the convenience of General public, voter list of last SIR (Year 2002) has been uploaded on the website of CEO, Delhi at the link https://www.ceodelhi.gov.in/ElectoralRoll_2002.aspx

9. In case any elector has settled in Delhi after 2002, he/she will be required to fill last SIR details of his/her native state from where he/she came and was registered as an elector in that state. Electoral Roll of all states is available on the ECI's portal at following link: <https://voters.eci.gov.in/searchInSIR/S2UA4DPDF-JK4QWODSE>
10. In those cases where the name of an elector does not appear in the voter list of last SIR (Year 2002/2003/2004/2005) as the case may be, but the name of parents/grand parents appears in the voter list of last SIR, he/she has to fill details of their parents/grand parents in the Enumeration Form.

11. Public can call 1950 for any assistance related to SIR & other electoral activities. ECI has also provided a “Book-A-Call” facility on the ECINet for the public to contact their Booth Level Officers(BLOs).
12. Helpdesks have also been set up in all District Headquarters and Voter Centres of respective Assembly Constituencies. List of Voters Centres is available on the website of CEO, Delhi at following link:-

13. All eligible electors are requested to actively participate in the SIR process and cooperate with the election officials during the house-to-house visits and ensure that filled in Enumeration Form is submitted to the BLO timely.
14. Electors can also avail facility to fill Enumeration Form online at www.voters.eci.gov.in
15. No document has to be submitted alongwith Enumeration Form.
