PRESS NOTE

Draft Electoral Rolls of SIR in Delhi were published on 31st August 2026. There are various media reports published on the Draft Rolls and ASDD list in Print and Social Media. In view of above, General Electors of NCT of Delhi and Political Parties are hereby informed that those electors who were not available/found shifted at the registered address of the electors during house to house visit by BLOs were marked as Absent, Shifted, Dead & Duplicate Electors (ASDD). BLOs completed house to house visits after due information to BLAs and conducted meetings with them periodically.

On the basis of information submitted by the BLOs, list of ASDD electors has been generated through ECINet in the format given by the Election Commission of India and same has been uploaded on the website of CEO, Delhi.

As regards not mentioning of address of deleted electors is concerned, the BLAs-2 who are appointed by political parties polling station wise, should have noted the addresses of ASDD electors from concerned BLOs during the meetings. It is pertinent to mention that Political parties were requested to direct their Booth Level Agents/BLAs to approach their BLOs and note down the addresses of electors who have been shown under ASDD list. Copy of the said letter is attached.

Reasons of Forms that are uncollectable has been categorized under following 5 category:

- (1) Death,
- (2) Untraceable/Absent,
- (3) Permanently Shifted,
- (4) Already Enrolled,
- (5) Others.

Such electors who have failed to furnish Enumeration Forms within the stipulated time have been placed under the category concerned. However, for specific reasons, MOM uploaded by BLOs may be referred.

Draft list has been prepared on the basis of Enumeration Forms received by the BLOs during House to House visit and only after due verification of Offline & Online Enumeration Forms received by the BLOs during the Enumeration phase.

General Public/Electors and representatives of Political Parties may also inspect/verify the Draft Photo Electoral Rolls at the offices of the Electoral Registration Officer/Assistant Electoral Registration Officer and with all the Booth Level Officers (BLOs) of Assembly Constituencies and also at all the Designated Locations (Polling Stations).

Copies of draft electoral roll in Hard copy & Soft Copy (without photos) have also been shared with the recognized political parties on 31.08.2026.

In case any elector was unable to submit their filled-in enumeration forms within the specified time (30th June to 17th Aug 2026), they may file Form 6 along with the prescribed Declaration Form for inclusion during the claims and objections period (31.08.2026 to 30.09.2026) to include their name in final electoral roll to be published on 04.11.2026.

The claims and objections can be filed in following forms:

- Form 6: Application for enrolment of new elector alongwith declaration & supportive documents.
- Form 6A: Application for addition by Overseas Indian
- Form 7: Application for objecting proposed inclusion or seeking deletion of existing entry
- Form 8: Shifting of residence within or outside constituency by existing elector, application for correction in particulars, replacement of EPIC without correction and marking of PWD elector, alongwith declaration & supportive documents.

Application forms may be submitted physically to the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO), Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (AERO), Booth Level Officers (BLO) and also at Designated Locations (polling stations).

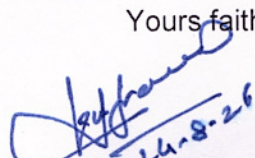
Please refer to your letters dated 05th Aug 2026 & 13th Aug 2026 forwarded through email dated 13th Aug 2026 on the subject cited above.

In this regard, I am directed to inform that:-

- (i) As per revised schedule of SIR, last date for submission of Enumeration Forms (Either offline or online) was 17.08.2026 and the same was duly communicated to all the DEOs/EROs/AEROs vide letter no. F.2(561)/CEO/ER/2025/PF3/1628 dated 04.08.2026 and also intimated to all recognized political parties vide letter dated F.2(561)/CEO/ER/2025/PF3/1627 dated 04.08.2026. Enumeration Forms have been collected by the BLOs till last date i.e. 17.08.2026, as per revised schedule in all ACs. If there is any particular case of not accepting Enumeration Forms during the extended period, the same may be communicated to this office.
- (ii) List of Uncollectable Enumeration Forms (Absent, Shifted, Dead & Duplicate Electors) have been shared by the BLOs with respective BLAs appointed by the recognized political parties. The same will also be uploaded on the website of CEO, Delhi i.e. www.ceo.delhi.gov.in in due course. Further, it is informed that address of ASDD Electors, if required may be noted down from the BLOs by the BLAs. This has already been communicated to all the districts.
- (iii) As regards providing printed Frozen Photo Electoral Roll & list of unmapped electors, it is reiterated that provisions of ECI contained in Registration of Electors Rules, 1960 states that "the recognized political parties should be supplied, free of cost, One Soft Copy (in the form of Image PDF without the photograph of electors) and one Hard Copy of the roll at the time of publication of draft and final roll". Accordingly, all the recognized political parties are supplied draft & final electoral rolls as & when they are published in accordance with the provisions of the ECI.
- (iv) All activities related to SIR is being carried out strictly in accordance with the timelines/instructions of the Commission.

Sub: - Serious irregularities, Discrepancies and Violation of Supreme Court Mandates in the Ongoing Special Intensive Revision (SIR), 2026-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your representation dated 06.08.2026 and meeting with the Chief Electoral Officer, Delhi on the subject cited above. In this regard, it is informed that :-

1. During SIR, Booth level Officers (BLOs) are visiting each house hold from 30.6.2026 to 17.8.2026 for distribution the pre-printed Enumeration forms in duplicate to the existing electors and guide them in filling up the form. Further, meetings will be called with BLAs during and at the end of enumeration phase for sharing the list of uncollectable enumeration forms identifying electors under category of ASDD (absent, shifted, dead, duplicate and others). Hence, BLO cannot mark any elector as shifted until and unless it is confirmed during H-2-H visit. In case BLA finds the report factually incorrect, he may point out the same to BLO/AERO/ERO. The same shall be re-verified and updated if found true. ERO has the power to roll back the entries so that the records are properly updated. Instructions have again been issued to all DEOs to strictly follow all instructions of the ECI in letter & spirit.
2. Section 19 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 on "conditions of Registration" says every person who is ordinarily resident in a constituency shall be entitled to be registered in the electoral at the place where he is "ordinarily resident". The meaning of "ordinary resident" has been defined under Section 20 of Representation of the People Act, 1950. BLO have to distribute Enumeration form to the electors found residing at the registered address at the time of H2H visit. BLO will not be able to distribute Enumeration Form to an elector who has moved/shifted to a new location as the elector may not be available at the registered address as mentioned in Electoral Roll and has ceased to be "ordinarily resident" of the area.

These shifted electors can file Form-6 alongwith declaration Form prescribed by the Commission during the period for filling claim & objection w.e.f. 24.08.2026 to 23.09.2026 for inclusion of their name at new address in the final roll.

No Enumeration Forms is rejected on the ground that an elector has failed to submit his last SIR details. It is again clarified that all Enumeration forms received by BLOs will be included in the draft roll. BLOs have been instructed to assist electors facing difficulty in filling up the forms. Such electors who have failed to provide previous SIR electoral roll details in the Enumeration Form shall be issued notice to provide documents as the case may be from the list of documents as prescribed by the Commission for establishing their eligibility to be an elector.

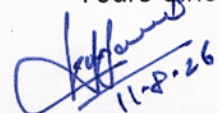

3. Presently, BLOs are on field visits to collect the Enumeration forms. District Election Officers are again being instructed to issue necessary orders to ensure BLOs attend to the call of citizens and collect the Enumeration forms from the electors. BLOs have already been instructed to assist electors facing difficulty in filling up the forms.
4. Awareness Videos regarding Searching names in the last SIR Electoral Rolls/How to fill Enumeration Forms & other similar material have been circulated on the social media handles of CEO, Delhi/Districts of NCT of Delhi.
5. As per instructions, BLO are required to visit house to house in their allotted area of distribution & collection of Forms. The electors can utilise the facility of "Book-A-Call with BLOs" for any query/assistance with regard to filing of Enumeration Form or collection thereof.
6. Details of electors deleted prior to start of SIR is available in Monthly Pooling section available on the website of CEO, Delhi at link <https://ceodelhinet.nic.in/ceodelhiweb/erollReport.aspx>
7. All eligible citizens, whose names does not figure in the draft roll, may apply for inclusion of their names in electoral roll by submitting Form-6 online or offline. Their cases will be processed during the period of claims and objection from 24.8.2026 to 22.10.2026. If their claim is found to be in order and correct, their name will be included in the final roll of SIR to be published on 27.10.2026.
The list of ASDD electors will also be uploaded on the website of CEO, Delhi as per Commission instructions. As regards mentioning address of the deleted voters, the BLA appointed by political parties may note the same from their respective BLOs during BLO-BLA meeting.
8. Matter of electors residing in Jhuggi Jhopri cluster in Jailor Wala Bagh of AC-17 Wazirpur was raised stating that the Jhuggi cluster was demolished and the residents were shifted/relocated to new flats given by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi. The electors of these Jhuggi Jhopri Clusters should not have been deleted as they were allotted new flats under the relocation programme.

In this regard, it was informed that as per information available and provided by ERO of AC-17, Wazirpur Assembly Constituency, New Sections namely Swabhiman Apartment Block A, B & C has been created in PS 39, 40 & 41 and electors (details of residents of Jailor Wala Bagh received from DDA) were asked to fill Form-8 alongwith their family members to change their address in E-roll. A meeting with BLAs of all Political Parties was also held on 17.10.2025 to discuss above said course of action. As on date, residents of Jailor Wala Bagh have been enrolled as elector with their present address. And they are being provided Enumeration Forms at the newly registered address.
9. Further, it is requested to kindly issue directions to all the BLAs of your party to participate in the ongoing SIR and cooperate with the respective BLOs of their parts and also create awareness amongst the electors to submit the Enumeration Forms to their BLOs, if not submitted till date as last date for submission of Enumeration Form is 17.08.2026.
