PRESS NOTE

1. Election Commission of India in exercise of its powers under Article 324, Section 21 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 along with other applicable provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1950, has directed to begin the Special Intensive Revision(SIR) in the NCT of Delhi vide letter dated 14.05.2026 for the discharge of its constitutional mandate to protect the integrity of the electoral rolls.

2. Detailed schedule of the SIR is given below:-

3. Main objective of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) is **“No eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll”**. Every person who is a citizen of India and who is not less than eighteen years of age on the qualifying date and is not otherwise disqualified under any law shall be entitled to be registered in the electoral roll.

4. During SIR, BLOs will conduct House to House enumeration. **Every existing elector, whose name exists in the electoral roll will be made available an Enumeration Form (in duplicate)** through BLOs. Elector has to fill the enumeration form filling his/her required details and has to return one copy to the BLO. Provision will also be given to electors to fill Enumeration Form online during SIR period.

5. For the convenience of General public, voter list of last Special Intensive Revision held in year 2002 in Delhi has been uploaded on the website of CEO, Delhi at the link https://www.ceodelhi.gov.in/ElectoralRoll_2002.aspx . Further, voters who have shifted in Delhi from other states after 2002 can find their names in ECI's Portal at <https://voters.eci.gov.in/searchInSIR/S2UA4DPDF-JK4QWODSE>

6. All the Electors who are permanently staying in Delhi prior to 2002, can check their name in the voter list of 2002 available on the website of Chief Electoral Officer, Delhi and note down your details (relative name, State Name, AC Name, AC Number, Part No, Sr No.) as appearing in the voter list of 2002.

And in case if any elector has come from other State and settled in Delhi after 2002, their name will not appear in 2002 voter list of Delhi. In such case, electors are requested to search their details from www.voters.eci.gov.in and note down their details (relative name, State Name, AC Name, AC Number, Part No, Sr No.) as appearing in the voter list of 2002/2003/2005 (year of last SIR held in that particular State, as the case may be).

7. Keep this information Handy for filling the details of electors/relatives of the last SIR in the Enumeration Form provided by BLO. No document is required to be submitted with the Enumeration Form.
8. In such cases where the name of present elector does not appear in the voter list of year 2002 but the name of his parents (Father & Mother) appears in the voter list of year 2002. He has to provide details of their parents/relatives in the Enumeration Form.
9. Rationalization of polling stations will also be undertaken during this period. ECI has reduced the limit of 1500 voter per polling station to 1200 voters per polling station for ease of electors during the poll.
10. Regular meetings will also be conducted by the CEO/DEOs/EROs with the recognized political parties seeking their cooperation for successful completion of SIR in accordance with the instructions of the ECI. First such meeting with recognized political parties is scheduled in the coming week to inform them of the important points of law and procedures of the SIR and seek their cooperation.
11. CEO, Delhi has also called a meeting with all District Election Officers to review preparedness for SIR in the coming week.
