PRESS NOTE

1. Election Commission of India in exercise of its powers under Article 324, Section 21 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 along with other applicable provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1950, has announced the schedule for Special Intensive Revision(SIR) in the NCT of Delhi.
2. Since many changes have occurred in the existing electoral roll due to frequent migration which has resulted in electors getting registered in more than one place, non removal of dead voters the Election Commission announced the Special Intensive Revision with the objective that **"No eligible citizen is left out and no ineligible person is included."**
3. Detailed schedule of SIR is given below:-

4. In accordance with the directions of Election Commission of India, a training was held for SDMs(Election), Electoral Registration Officers (EROs), Asstt. Electoral Registration Officers (AEROs), FSOs who are also notified as AEROs, BLO Supervisors of all 13 districts of NCT of Delhi and also for Booth Level Agents (BLAs-1) of 06 recognized political parties at IIIDEM, Dwarka, New Delhi on 10.06.2026 on various aspects of Special Intensive Revision, 2026 in 02 sessions in collaboration with Technical Experts from ECI.
5. In the 1st session, detailed procedure of working on various ECINet IT modules at the level of ERO& BLO was explained by the Technical team of the ECI. Roles & responsibilities of EROs & BLOs during SIR were also explained by CEO, Delhi.
6. Various doubts/clarifications of the participants was also cleared by the ECI Team and Sh. Ashok Kumar CEO, Delhi during the training session on technical aspects and other related matters.
7. Further trainings will be held for all Booth Level Officers(BLOs) in the coming days at District level in all districts of NCT of Delhi.

8. In the 2nd session of the training, Booth Level Agent (BLAs-1) of 06 recognised Political parties were briefed about the important points of the law and procedures of the SIR. Total 187 BLAs-1 from 06 recognised Political parties attended the training session organized by office of CEO, Delhi. The participation of Political Parties is crucial at various stages of SIR for preparation of healthy and error free Electoral Roll.
9. In order to enhance participation by the recognised political parties at grass root level during preparation and revision of electoral roll, the Election Commission introduced a system of appointment of Booth Level Agents. BLA-1 are appointed at AC Level and BLA-2 at Booth level in respect of each polling station.
10. During the period of SIR, regular interactions will be done with the BLAs at AC level as well as Booth level. Before H2H enumeration, BLO will hold meetings with BLA-2 to brief them about the schedule and process of SIR.
11. To ensure more involvement of political parties, the Commission has allowed BLAs of recognized political parties to file applications in bulk, subject to the condition that a BLA shall not submit more than 50 Forms/day to BLO before the Draft Publication, and 10 Forms/day thereafter.
12. Certain queries were raised by the political parties regarding the SIR. Shri Balram Meena Jt. CEO, Delhi clarified the issues raised by the parties.
13. Few glimpses of the Training session:-
