1. Election Commission of India on 14.05.2026 announced schedule of Special Intensive Revision in NCT of Delhi with main objective **"No eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll"** as per details given below:-

6. Electors appearing in Draft Electoral Roll are categorized as under:-

- (i) who have mapped /linked themselves with self or their progeny entries in electoral rolls of Intensive revision of the respective states.
- (ii) Who could not link themselves with the electoral roll of last revision of respective states.

Draft Electoral Rolls available on the website of CEO, Delhi, offices of the ERO/AERO of Assembly Constituencies and at all the Designated Locations (Polling Stations).

7. **Period of Claims & Objections: Issuance of Notices**

Notices are being issued to the electors :-

- (i) who could not be linked with the electoral roll of last revision and
- (ii) those having logical discrepancies in their linking with the electoral roll of last revision.

Electors have to submit reply/requisite documents to the ERO concerned on receipt of Notice. Disposal of Notices will be completed by 29.10.2026.

List of electors to whom Notices have been issued is available on the websites of CEO, Delhi & District Election Officers and Voter Centers.

As on date, **31,63,930** Notices have been generated and are being delivered to electors concerned of NCT of Delhi.

As per instructions of the Commission dated 14.05.2026 contained in para 4 (b) regarding Publication of Draft Roll, ***“all names of member of judiciary, public representatives, holders of declared offices and personalities from fields of arts, culture, journalism, sports, and public services etc. earlier flagged in the electoral database, have been included in the draft Electoral Rolls, so that necessary documents can also be collected during the period of Claims and Objections.”***

8. **Inclusion of Names in the Electoral Roll:**

In case name is not present in the Draft Electoral Roll and having claim of being genuine elector, citizen may file Form 6 along with supporting documents during the claims and objections period (31.08.2026 to 30.09.2026) to include their name in final electoral roll to be published on 04.11.2026.

The claims and objections can be filed in following forms:

- Form 6: Application form for New Voters.
- Form 6A: Application for Inclusion of Name in Electoral Roll by an Overseas Elector
- Form 7: Voter Application Form for Objection for Proposed Inclusion/ Deletion of Name in Existing Electoral Roll
- Form 8: Voter Application Form for shifting of Residence/Correction of Entries in Existing Electoral Roll/Replacement of EPIC/Marking of PwD

9. Modes of Submission of Forms

Offline Mode

Forms may be submitted physically to the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO), Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (AERO), Booth Level Officers (BLO) and also at Designated Locations (polling stations) between 31.08.2026 to 30.09.2026.

Online Mode

10. Special Camps

Special Camps was organized in '**Bela Estate**' for enrollment of electors in AC-20 (Chandni Chowk)

Electors of '**Bela Estate**' which was got demolished prior to start of SIR were not found at their registered address, Hence these were placed in category of uncollectable forms under ASDD Electors. But now a campaign was organized for enrolment of electors of Bela Estate. 309 Forms were received during the Camp. This shows Commitment of the Commission to ensure inclusion of all eligible voters.

- Special Camps will be organised on **20.09.2026 (Sunday)** and **27.09.2026 (Sunday)** at all the polling station locations of NCT Delhi from **10 AM to 5 PM**.
- Special Camps have also been planned on **23.09.2026 (Wednesday)** & **24.09.2026 (Thursday)** from **5.00 PM to 9.00 PM** at all DUSIB night shelters and other such pockets for Homeless Electors, Third Gender & Sex Workers of NCT of Delhi .
